### **Bluetooth Functionality Descriptions:**

**Mono Headset (HSP)** - Supports use of a headset for mono (not stereo) voice (not high fidelity audio).

**Stereo Headset (A2DP)** - Supports use of a stereo headset device for stereo audio.

**Handsfree Kit (HFP)** - Similar to headset, but applies to Bluetooth devices that are installed somewhere (e.g.car, conference room).

**Dial Up Networking (DUN) 1XRTT** - Allows Bluetooth device to be used as a data modem by another devices, such as a laptop or PDA, over the Verizon Wireless 1xRTT data network, providing typical downlink speeds of 60-80 Kbps.

**Dial Up Networking (DUN) EVDO** - Allows Bluetooth device to be used as a data modem by another devices, such as a laptop or PDA, over the Verizon Wireless wireless broadband network, providing maximum download speeds of 460 kbps. Further, typical operating conditions and radio interference (including interference from WiFi networks, cordless telephones and microwaves) may significantly diminish speeds. Verizon Wireless is unable to provide an estimate of typical speeds.

**Serial Port (SPP)** - Allows Bluetooth to replicate the same functionality as a device's serial port.

**Object Push for vCard (OPP)** - Allows the capability to push a vCard to another Bluetooth enabled device.

**Syncing - Phonebook to PC** - Allows the syncing of contact information (please note device footnote – may require associated PC software).

**Syncing – Calendar to PC** - Allows the syncing of calendar information (please note device footnote – may require associated PC software).

**File Move File Movement (FTP)** – Allows the capability to send or receive data files. Please note that FTP file transfer is not available for all content and all folders. There are certain types of content (including, but not limited to, copyright protected content such as ringtones and wallpaper) that are excluded from FTP file transfers.

**Basic Printing (BPP)** – Allows printing of JPEG image files to a Bluetooth enabled printer.

**Human Interface Device (HID)** – Allows the use of a wireless joystick, mouse, or keyboard as an input device to the mobile device.

**Audio/Video Remote Control (AVRCP)** - Allows the device to become a standard interface to control TV's and hi-fi equipment or other single remote control devices.
